Naming Moodle activities logically provides clarity for students, and makes grading and course organization easier for you.

## **Suggested Format**

Activity [week#].#: Descriptive Title

## Recommendations

- Use a different name for each activity. Activity titles appear in the gradebook, so if every activity has the same name, e.g., Weekly Activity, it will be difficult to differentiate between gradebook items.
- **Number the activities.** Indicate the week number, then number activities in order of when they are due, e.g., 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, etc.
- Examples.
  - o Activity 2.1: Intrusion Detection
  - o Activity 2.2: Final Paper Topic
  - Activity 2.3: Reflection
- Add key words. While icons indicate the activity type, this might not be apparent to students. Consider adding activity type to the name, e.g., *Activity 2.1 (Forum): Intrusion Detection* or *Activity 3.4: Chapters 1-5 Quiz*.
